PATHWAY 2

Nursing Programme (AMCA)



Medical Assistant Certificate Programme is designed to prepare students to obtain entry-level employment as a Nursing Assistant or a Phlebotomy Technician. This programme offers students the opportunity to learn the necessary knowledge and skills both in the classroom and in a supervised clinical practice. The students learn how to prepare patients for various technical examinations such as EKGs and Phlebotomy, as well as how to perform several such procedures.

Level 2 Food Preparation and Culinary Arts/Food and Beverage (City & Guilds)



The Culinary Arts/Food and Beverage Diploma Programme offers students the opportunity to acquire the skills and knowledge needed to obtain an entry-level position in the field or to higher level universities' qualifications. Students will gain hands-on knowledge of sauces, meats, and restaurant operations. In addition, they will learn about kitchen safety and sanitation techniques to ensure food safety.

Level 3 Motor Vehicle Repairs (City & Guilds)



This qualification is for students wanting to develop some of the key skills and understanding in motor vehicle systems. This significant and robust qualification will give students the skills needed to apply for an automotive leadership or similar engineering pathway. It permits students to learn, develop and practice the skills.
